Approximately <u>**11.3**</u> million children in Yemen require humanitarian assistance



There are about <u>**1.6**</u> million Yemeni children who are internally displaced



There is a minimum of <u>2</u> million children in Yemen who are out of school due to COVID-19



The Yemeni Crisis has negatively impacted <u>21</u> million people million people.



It is projected that 2.3 million Yemeni children (under the age of five) will suffer from acute malnutrition in 2021.

In honour of this event, the YBH team challenges each person who donates to join us in walking 1 cm for each displaced child on October 2nd.



The money donated will help UNICEF reach their goals of aiding:

- 275,000 malnourished children with critical life-saving supplies and care
- 5 million people with safe and clean water to stop the spread of life-threatening diseases
- Nearly 1 million children with vaccines and healthcare
- 9 million people with emergency cash assistance to help families buy basic commodities so they can survive
